Synopsis:	Hong Kong is a fast growing city built on a relatively small area of land. As a result, there is high development pressure on the remaining available pieces of land, especially wetlands such as wet farmland, fishponds, marshes and streams. This pressure often results in the loss of the wetland if no further action is taken to conserve or compensate for those affected area. In recent years, this has led to the development of techniques for the restoration, creation and enhancement of local wetlands. Engineers play an important role in the planning and implementation of many development projects that may affect wetlands. Enhancing the knowledge, concern and understanding of engineers through presentations and discussion will, therefore, raise their awareness of the importance and conservation of wetlands. This workshop will provide a platform to allow representatives from different environmental parties to present their work on the restoration, creation and enhancement of wetlands in Hong Kong.
